A. Target Applicants : Applicants who have graduated (or are expected to graduate) from high school, or who are able to submit a graduation certificate with Apostille or consular authentication

B. Eligibility Requirements

1) Applicants and both parents must be foreign nationals, and must meet all of the following conditions:

C. Notifications

- a. All documents in foreign languages other than English must be accompanied by a notarized Korean translation.
- b. For graduation (or expected graduation) certificates and transcripts issued by overseas institutions, an Apostille Certificate must be obtained from the designated authority in the country where the school is located. Applicants from non-Apostille countries must obtain Consular Authentication from the Korean consulate in the school's country. Applicants with academic credentials from China must submit an Academic Credential Report issued by the China Academic Degrees and Graduate Education Development Center.
- c. The Certificate of Admission will be issued only to applicants who pass the document screening and interview, and who have paid the full tuition fee.
- d. Applicants who are absent from the interview or score below 70 points will not be admitted.
- e. All international students are required to purchase health insurance at their own expense.
- f. Even if an applicant has been admitted and registered, admission will be canceled in the event of visa issuance refusal or failure to enter Korea.
- g. If it is confirmed that admission was obtained through falsification or alteration of documents, or by other fraudulent means, the admission or enrollment will be revoked.
- h. During the admission process, applicants will be individually notified of announcements, interview schedules, and admission results.

2. Program Operation Status

A. Program Structure. A total of 8 classes are offered(Each class accommodates up to 20 students)

II. Admission Schedule, Eligibility, and Required Documents

1. Admission Schedule : The schedule varies depending on the visa application procedures of each country

2. Eligibility : Applicants must have graduated from high school or hold a higher level of education

3. Required Documents

- Application Form and Personal Statement (University-designated forms)
 - Certificate of Graduation and Academic Transcript (one copy each, Apostille original)
 - Copy of each parent's ID
 - Copy of the applicant's family register and ID (for all family members)
 - Certificate of Employment and Proof of Income of parents (for self-employed, relevant supporting documents required)
 - Bank Balance Certificate (minimum KRW 10,000,000, issued within 30 days)
 - Certificate of Deposit for Study Abroad Expenses issued by a local bank in Vietnam (applicable only to Vietnamese applicants, must be maintained for 1 year)
 - Copy of Passport
 - Photos (3 cm × 4 cm, 4 copies)
 - Additional documents may be requested depending on the applicant's circumstances
- ※ All documents must be translated into Korean or English
